

October 10, 2015 Reclaiming Our Roots - Rickey Cotton - Tampa Bay, FL

Rickey Cotton is a commissioned presenter of Centering Prayer and Lectio Divina and a member of the faculty for Contemplative Outreach's Living Flame program. Rickey has developed and presented a number of contemplative workshops in various states, including ones on Meister Eckhart and Raimon Panikkar's Christophany. He lives in Lakeland, FL, where he is a Professor of English at Southeastern University and former department chair. He also facilitates a local Centering Prayer group. From 2003-2010, he served as a member of the Leadership Team of Contemplative Outreach of Tampa Bay.
